CPR/AED/Narcan Training Class

Being prepared for an emergency is another way to serve our neighbor. Trinity's Council and Mental Health/Substance Abuse Task Force have worked together to bring a CPR/AED/Narcan training class to Trinity on June 24th @ 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. In this class, you will learn and practice CPR. We will also spend time learning how to use the AED in case someone is having a heart issue. Trinity will have Narcan in the building soon in case there is an opioid overdose on our premises. The cost is \$20 per person. You can pay in advance or drop off a check to the office (label it "Narcan Training Class.") There is room for 24 people at this class – sign-up at the welcome center to pre-register.



How full is your bucket?

Some people have a "bucket list," the list of things they want to see or do during their lifetime. Perhaps you aren't a list-making person, but you do have a bucket. Your bucket is the collection of internal resources you draw on when someone needs support or care from you. You may need to use your patience, your empathy, your listening skills, your faith, your energy – to give the "cup of cold water" someone needs from you at a tough time in his or her life.

If you are distributing real cups of water from a bucket full of water, pretty soon your cup will be scraping the bottom of the bucket – unless you go back to the pump (or faucet) and refill your bucket. The same thing can happen to your bucket of internal resources. Your bucket may have emptied because you were providing care or just because of stresses in your own life (like the winter of 2022-23 that seemed like it would never end). So how do you refill your bucket? The answer may be different for each of us. It might be as simple as spending a little time alone, doing a favorite activity, talking with that person you go to when you need comfort or support, or setting aside time to "take it to the Lord in prayer."

Do you feel guilty when you do something just for yourself? Many caregivers do. However, if you go to the Gospels you will find out that Jesus retreated from the crowds to be alone or just with a few

people. He needed to refill his bucket, too, after meeting the needs of hundreds or even thousands of people who came to him for healing.

Your car won't continue to run if you don't put fuel into it when the needle of the gas gauge is resting on "E." You won't be able to provide the care that is needed by someone if you are "running on empty" physically, emotionally or spiritually. What works for you? How can you refill your bucket so you can offer that "cup of cold water?" Think about it...


