At a baptismal font once upon a time, you were set free. In the splashing of water, in the marking of the cross you became a beloved child of God who no longer needs to worry about sin, death or evil. Through those waters you have been freed to live, love and serve your neighbor. This freedom is a cause for celebration.

In the next few days you will receive the kick-off letter for our Fall Stewardship Campaign we are calling *The Freedom Campaign*. This year's campaign is a bit different though – it is a joint Fall Stewardship Campaign about the annual budget and funding our Christ-centerred daily ministry but it also includes Phase Two of our Capital Campaign.

To explain, the coming letter have a "Giving Intent Card" for the annual budget and a Capital Campaign Pledge sheet. Why both at the same time? Because we felt it would be the most transparent way to come to the congregation. All of us know that the congregation is only able to engage in Christ-centered ministry because of the generosity of each and every member. As members, we also know that a Special Congregational Meeting approved the installation of a Fire Detection/Alarm System and a Capital Campaign to pay the \$358,000 expense. Giving our members the opportunity to prayerfully consider what they might financially share out of what God has first given seemed like the right thing to do.

Realize there is a big difference between the Giving Intent and the Capital Campaign Pledge. The Giving Intent is what you plan to be able to share with Trinity through regular offering – whether you place it in the offering plate, have it electronically transferred from your bank to Trinity's or by using our VANCO app – these funds pay for staff, ministry activities like Church School, Confirmation and Bible Study. The Capital Campaign Pledge is the amount you plan to give over the next several years to help fund the installation of the Fire Detection/Alarm System.

To help kick off Phase 2 of the Capital Campaign, a Trinity couple has come forward with a challenge gift of \$50,000. They are offering to match dollar for dollar every financial gift given to the Capital Campaign before the end of October. Their desire is to ensure we have the cash in hand to pay for the cost of the fire detection system and its installation without taking out a loan.

Heather Baumann, our Financial Administrator, is willing to have a confidential conversation to answer any questions. More general questions can be asked of members of Council, Stewardship Committee and the Capital Campaign Committee after our worship services.

The bottom line is God has generously blessed us. Trinity members have a history of generosity – it is part of our culture as a congregation. The ministry we do happens because of that generosity. Each day we are thankful for that generosity because it means we are able to boldly proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ.




### "Considering Matthew Shepard" Concert by Dakota Pro Musica

Drop off prescription glasses at the office. We will contact Bismarck Lions to come and collect them.




#### **RMHC Pull Tabs**

# **Trust Fund Spotlight**

### Giving From Your IRA May SAVE You Money!



distributions (QCD). A qualified charitable distribution is a way you can give to the Trinity Lutheran Trust Fund to strengthen ministry and produce tax savings for you!

Avoid income tax by giving directly to Trinity Lutheran Church Trust Fund from your IRA—never in your pocket! With a qualified charitable distribution (QCD), a check goes directly from your IRA to the trust fund. Many people who are facing RMDs that will have tax implications could make a gift to the Trust Fund through their QCD and never have to show it as income. The assets MUST go directly to the Trust Fund.

Here is an important distinction: these are NOT tax deductions. They do not provide a charitable deduction regardless of whether you itemize deductions. The tax benefit is the ability to exclude the donated distribution from taxable income!

We encourage everyone to discuss this with their financial planner or tax consultant, - and be sure to let your family know! It could be a savings for you and a blessing to the Trinity Lutheran Church Trust Fund.


