


We're adding a new faith milestone to our rotation and need your help! We are going to pair up each of our 2nd graders with a member of the congregation to be prayer partners.

### Reduce Your Weight!

Yes, there is a weight-reduction technique that really can work for you – but it's not a quick way to drop 10 or 20 pounds. It's losing the weight you may be carrying on your heart.

Sometimes everything is going well for you, and you feel "lighter than air," but negative emotions can weigh you down. Perhaps you are angry at something that someone said or did to you. Perhaps you resent a decision you feel was unfair. Perhaps someone's (or some group's) behavior is so offensive or hateful that you feel hate in return. These emotions have weight that can't be measured in pounds and ounces, but you carry that weight with you. What makes these emotions even more frustrating is that (1) the situation is important to you, but others see it as "no big deal" and have already moved on; (2) the person or group you feel negative about doesn't know or doesn't care how you feel; (3) there is no way to let the person or group know "You hurt me!" (4) There is no way to strike back (or you know that "getting even" would only make things worse).

If there is no fix for what weighs you down, and you would like to focus your energy on other parts of your life, can you let the hurt/resentment/anger go? If you would like to "let go", how can you do that?

- Talk it out in detail and in confidence with a good listener (such as a Stephen Minister), who accepts what you say without judging you or your situation. Sometimes just hearing yourself explain what happened and how you feel is enough to reduce the weight you carry.
- Write it out. Some people find journaling helpful or even writing a letter to the person who hurt you. WARNING! Do not send the letter. Write it. Read it as often as you need to, and then shred or burn it. It's simply a tool to help you "get it out of your system".
- First, last, and always take your burdens to the Lord in prayer. The Bible tells us how and why to do this. *Cast all your anxiety on him, because he cares for you.* (1 Peter 5:7, NRSV). Remember that's ALL your anxiety, ALL your cares, ALL your burdens because if a care is too small to be carried as a prayer, then it is too small to be carried as a burden.

**During Lent** 


