It was not a peaceful end to the year for me. Telling an employee their time on staff has come to an end is never pleasant. Uncovering a financial mess and then having to involve police is overwhelming. I was not alone. It was not a peaceful process for the Council Executive Committee or the Council. It has



not been a peaceful process for members of the congregation, some who have written checks that are missing (but have not been cashed), or were just saddened by what has appeared in the newspaper. For those who do not know – Trinity's former financial administrator was arrested just days before Christmas and has been charged with fraud, theft and unauthorized use of personal information. Peace was a precious commodity in those days.

Life is not always easy. Things happen, people take silly actions, life gets messy and it is right into the midst of all of that Jesus' word is meant to be heard. His gifting of peace is spoken just hours before he is arrested, beaten and eventually killed. He knows how difficult what lies ahead will be on his followers. So, he gives them this word.

Trinity is blessed. Members who care, a council who is willing to do the hard work, staff that have passion for the Gospel and more. We are blessed that God has provided us with a new finance person who knows accounting and knows the church management software Trinity uses. Brent Winkelman is digging his way through this mess, he is asking lots of questions and together we are putting the pieces together. It will take time but we will be able to get our finances in order.

What has given me comfort, strength and hope is the way you all have reacted. Words of support, hugs, offers of help in any way possible, by your asking good questions in constructive ways (even when we don't have answers or couldn't answer). Council members not hiding from the situation and willing to lead. I am thankful and grateful. Peace will come as a gift from the Savior. Peace will be with us as we focus on Jesus and his desire that all people rest in him.


