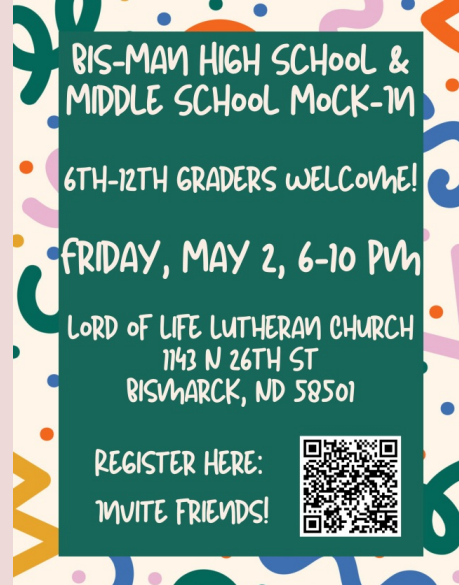


### Campships

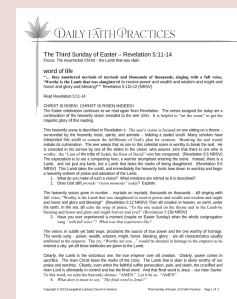
