



Does time "heal all wounds"?

I read something recently that changes this message...

Time does not heal. It's what you do with the time that brings healing.

Dr. Kenneth Haugk, the founder of Stephen Ministry, points out that bottling up feelings gives them a tighter hold on you. (Think about the anger that still lurks in the pit



Dealing with a strong emotion – such as grief – is a process. It may be different for you than for someone else who is grieving. Some grievers find that participating in a support group can be a helpful way to work through their feelings. A good support group is confidential. What you say during the group meeting stays within the group and is not reported or discussed outside the group meeting. It is also non-judgmental. The feelings you express are not "good" or "bad". They are simply what you are feeling now, and they are accepted as such by the other group members. (And these feelings will change as you work through your grief).

Trinity has a grief support group. Any adult who is working through grief is welcome to attend. Your grief may be new, or it may be something you have been carrying inside you for years. If your grief is so new that you are not ready to talk about it, you can attend the group just to get a feeling for what happens and spend most of the time listening. If you are worried that you will cry – that is expected (and there are boxes of tissues on the table).


